# PLASTIC

Food pots, tubs, trays and punnets

### PLASTIC

Any other plastic, including soft film lids, medicine packs, laminated pouches (eg. bet food, coffee), plant pots, toys, bubble wrap, polystyrene, carrier bags

#### PLASTIC BOTTLES

Clear and coloured plastic bottles (lids can be left on)

# PLASTIC BOTTLES

Plastic bottles containing hazardous liquids and bottles that still contain food or drink

### PAPER

Newspapers, magazines, brochures, catalogues, shredded paper (not bagged), envelopes (including window envelopes but not envelopes with padding), wrapping paper (without glitter or tape), telephone directories

#### PAPER

Paper that is stained with food, grease, paint or dirt, nappies, wet wipes, crisps or sweet wrappers, wallpaper, non-paper giftwrap and bags, tissues and paper towels

#### CARDBOARD

Cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard, egg boxes, cardboard tubes, greetings cards (without glitter)

#### CARDBOARD

Card with food, dirt or paint on it, glitter-covered greet ngs cards

#### CARTONS

Food and drinks cartons (no lids)

#### CARTONS

Laminated plastic pouches

## TINS, CANS AND AEROSOLS

Food and drink cans, biscuit and chocolate tins, aluminium foil and trays, aerosol cans (lids removed), aluminium tubes (eg. tomato puree, toothoaste)

# TINS, CANS AND AEROSOLS

Foil with food on it, paint tins or metal containers for chemicals, cutlery, pots and pans, kettles, pipes, irons, gardening tools

#### GLASS

Clean bottles and jars (lids can be left

#### GLASS

Any other glass, including Pyrex, mirrors, windows and drinks glasses.
